The late-Precambrian Torridonian sediments of the Cape Wrath district, extreme north-west Scotland, unconformably overlie a planar, weathered Lewisian surface. This planar surface was partly stripped of its mantle of altered rock prior to burial beneath Torridonian alluvial fan deposits.
